
### **D-Day Skydive for Alabare**

### **Plot Synopsis**

### **My Personal Opinion**

Unfortunately, I did not enjoy this book very much. I found the story too unrealistic to be enjoyable, and a lot of the dialogue between characters, especially during moments such as rap battles, gave me second-hand embarrassment. This does not mean the book is entirely bad though, as there were aspects I did enjoy, such as seeing deeper into what kind of person Shaun is, but these ideas are not expanded upon enough for me to give much credit to it. In the end, I believe that this book had some good concepts within it, but they are buried behind so much unenjoyable content that it makes them irrelevant to my overall opinion.

#### **Suitable Audience**

In my opinion, this book would be enjoyed more and received better by a younger audience, potentially under the age of 13. I doubt many people older than this would enjoy it, as much of the humour feels immature, but maybe a younger audience may get something out of it that I unfortunately couldn't.
