THE STONEHENGE SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT

"As a pupil at this school I will

- ✓ attend school and lessons punctually and properly equipped
- ✓ do my best in class and with homework

alcohol, tobacco, lighters/matches, e-cigarettes, shisha pens, 'vapes', drugs, aerosols, chewing gum, firecrackers / fireworks, hooded tops or other items of non-school uniform, games consoles, stolen items, laser pens, knives, blades or other dangerous or valuable items

✓ uphold the reputation of the school on the journey to and from school, and on school trips
